 to and Eliza his wife and George W. Beers of Franklin County,  
 Jacob Sly & al and State of Ohio for and in consideration of the sum of  
 Thirty five dollars to us in hand paid the receipt whereof  
 is hereby acknowledged do grant, bargain sell and convey to Jacob Sly and Daniel  
 Lakin, George Whipple, Ransom Coe, and John Bickel and to their heirs and  
 assigns forever for the purposes hereinafter expressed the following piece or parcel  
 of land in said County of Franklin in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of the 1<sup>st</sup> Township and  
 48<sup>th</sup> Range of U. S. Military Lands Beginning at a stone in the State road  
 leading from Franklinton to Delaware and in the centre of the Township  
 road leading west from Piatt's Mills and run east along the centre of  
 said road 21 poles and 22 links to a stone thence S 3° W 10 $\frac{1}{2}$  poles to a stone  
 thence west 18 $\frac{1}{4}$  poles to a stone thence N 16 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 11 poles to the beginning  
 containing one and one third acre to be held in trust by them their  
 associates and successors for the sole use and purpose of a Burying ground  
 and for no other purpose unless it may be for the erection of a Church or  
 School house thereon Together with the hereditaments and appurtenances  
 therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining and all the estate right  
 title interest claim or demand whatsoever of us the said Solomon & wife  
 and George W. Beers either in law or equity of us and to the above bargained  
 premises to have and to hold the same to the said Jacob Sly and others  
 associated with him and to their heirs and assigns forever.

 have hereunto set our hands and seals the 28<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year 1824.


